"Brief Trip Summary"

Day 0 - Friday July 6 - If your flying into Chicago we suggest that you arrive in the afternoon, at O'Hare International Airport (ORD). You will be picked up at the airport and taken to the hotel. If you are riding your own motorcycle you will be given the location of the hotel. We would like everyone to arrive prior to 5:00 PM and be ready for the group welcome dinner at 7:00 PM. It will give everyone a chance to meet and get acquainted with those we will be riding with for the next two weeks. There will be a presentation on the ride and we will also have a safety presentation so we all understand how we will be riding together.

Day 1 - Saturday July 7 - Those needing rental motorcycles will pick them up in the morning. We will help with that entire process We will leave the hotel at 9:00 AM. Today's ride will be short giving you time to get acquainted with your rental motorcycle. We will arrive at the Harley Davidson Motorcycle Museum after lunch giving you ample time to enjoy the museum. Our hotel is near the museum.

Day 2- Sunday July 8 - A great day of riding from Milwaukee along Lake Michigan to scenic Door County Wisconsin. This is an easy day's ride of 225 miles. We will spend the evening in Sturgeon Bay Wisconsin.

Day 3 - Monday July 9 - We will ride from Sturgeon Bay, through Green Bay, and into the Upper Peninsula of Michigan. It will be a great day of riding along the northern shore of Lake Michigan. This will be a little longer riding day, 300 miles, but a very enjoyable riding day. We will spend the night in Saint Ignace.

Day 4 - Tuesday July 10 - We will start our day with a ride across the Mackinaw Bridge. It is truly an amazing experience if you have never done it before. After the crossing the Bridge in both directions, we will continue north to Lake Superior. This part of the Upper Peninsula is very remote, beautiful and with little traffic. It will be a great day of riding that will only end we reach our hotel in Marquette for the evening. This will be a very scenic 230 mile riding day.

Day 6 -Wednesday July 11 - We will continue west along Lake Superior and then into Wisconsin. We will spend the night in Bayfield Wisconsin. Bayfield is near the Apostle Island National Lakeshore and is a very beautiful area on Lake Superior. This will be a 260 mile riding day.

Day 7 -Thursday July 12 - We will continue to work our way around Lake Superior and into Minnesota. The ride along this section of Lake Superior is in every ride magazine because of it beautiful and pristine views along Lake Superior. We will spend the night in Grand Marais, Minnesota after a great 200 mile riding day.

Day 8 - Friday July 13 - Today is the first of five days riding in Canada. Please remember you must have a valid passport. Entering Canada has restrictions on what you can bring into Canada. There are limits on Alcohol, cigarettes, and more. We will provide you with that information prior to our departure. We will continue to ride along Lake Superior and through many small Canadian towns along it's shores. We will spend the night in Marathon after riding 270 miles.

Day 9 - Saturday July 14 - Our journey continues east along Lake Superior to Sault St Marie. Sault St Marie is famous for the Soo Locks that allow international shipping into Lake Superior. Much of the iron ore that produces steel is mined near Lake Superior and is shipped on ocean vessels through the Soo Locks. We will spend the night in Sault St. Marie after a 250 mile riding day.

Day 10- Sunday July 15 - After riding along Lake Superior for several days, today we ride along the shores of Lake Huron. This is a part of Canada and the Great lakes many people do not take the time to visit. We will ride along the North and Eastern Shores of Lake Huron. We will spend the night in Parry Sound, Ontario after a 290 mile riding day.

Day 11 - Monday July 16 - Mid day we will leave the shore of Lake Huron and head south to Lake Ontario. This region of Ontario is the more densely populated part of Ontario. They will reach the shores of Lake Ontario just west of Toronto. We will follow Lake Ontario west and south until we reach Niagara Falls. We will spend the night in Niagara Falls and we will take the opportunity to see the Falls.

Day 12 - Tuesday July 17 - This is our last day to ride in Ontario Canada and we will ride along the north shore of Lake Erie. Many years ago Lake Erie made a great transformation and is now one of the best fishing lakes of the Great Lakes. Today we return back to the United States so you will need your passport again and pass through American customs. We will spend the night in Port Huron, Michigan, after riding 250 miles, and we will be back on the west shore of Lake Huron.

Day 13 - Wednesday July 18 - Today we will continue to ride along the west shore of Lake Huron and ride along the "Mitten" of Michigan. It is called the mitten because it is shaped like a mitten. We will spend the evening in Alpena, Michigan after riding 290 miles.

Day 14 - Thursday July 19 - We will continue north along Lake Huron and stop for lunch in Mackinaw City. We will take the opportunity to shoot more photos of the Mackinaw Bridge. After lunch we will continue south along Lake Michigan. We will ride through the famous "tunnel of trees" before we reach Traverse City where we will spend the evening. This will be a 210 mile riding day because of all the stops we will be making along the way.

Day 15 Friday July 20 - We will continue south along the eastern shores of Lake Michigan. We will ride along Sleeping Bear Dune National Lake Shore. We will spend the evening in Holland Michigan after a 220 mile riding day. This will be our last night together and we will have our last group dinner of the trip.

Day 16 - Saturday July 21 - Today is our last day on the road and we should reach Chicago mid day to return the rental motorcycles. You will have the opportunity to catch a later afternoon flight or we can help you reserve a hotel for the evening. In total for the 16 days on the road we have rode approximately 3500 miles, in 2 countries and rode around/along all 5 of the Great Lakes. We will ride in some very sparsely populated areas, pristine views before reaching some of the highest populated areas of the USA and Canada. We created this tour to limit our time riding through the densely populated urban areas. The Great Lakes comprise 21% of the earth's fresh water and covers 94,250 square miles and seeing them on a motorcycle is truly an adventure.
